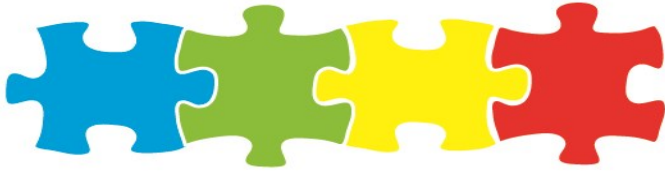

Cancellations, Postponements & Changes
