In the Explorer program, Explorers participate in a wide variety of extensive firefighting training. You will learn how to search for and rescue a victim in a fire situation with all the correct gear including the air pack. Another type of training is how to rapidly deploy a fire hose from a fire engine/truck, and successfully attach it to a hydrant. There are also many more training procedures conducted in the Explorer program including CPR, rescue breathing, the Heimlich, back-boarding, and assessing patients etc.... Physical fitness is also an important aspect within the Explorer program. You need to be physically fit to accomplish certain tasks that may be given to you at any time. There will also be much community service involvement in the program. You will be asked to participate in community service events for the Fire Department such as Muscular Dystrophy Association (MDA) events.
