POLICE INVESTIGATION:

A food vendor needs a state issued mobile food license before being able to legally sell perishable food (i.e. steak, pork, chicken, seafood, ice-cream, etc.) If you do not have a permit, one should be obtained from the Cerro Gordo County Health Department. Prior to processing your license application to sell product within the City of Mason City, the Cerro Gordo County Department of Public Health must review and approve your application.
